ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: This amendment will provide grant funding to allow the department to implement evidence based nutrition literacy curriculum to children that participate in the Parks and Recreation Department's Youth Meal Programs and summer wellness program that increase opportunities for physical activity. This action accepts and appropriates \$30,000 for these purposes. The General Fund will not be required to contribute additional funds beyond those currently budgeted to this grant. When the grant funds expire, the Parks and Recreation Department's need for continuing funding will be evaluated and may be denied.
