Art in Public Places Stakeholder Input Process

The Art in Public Places program strives to create artwork opportunities within an environment of collaboration and idea exchange, to help ensure overall success. Before each Call to Artists is approved and released, specific artwork goals are proposed and discussed by advisors, which can include the construction project team (City staff, project consultants such as architect, landscape architect, interior designer, engineers, etc.), community groups or individuals with relevant history or specific interest, neighborhood representatives, task force members, the Art in Public Places Panel, and the Austin Arts Commission. This shapes the type of artwork opportunity being offered to artists. Sometimes, a design charrette is conducted, or an artist is brought on to the design team to help identify future artwork opportunities.

Research on the facility or area where the construction is planned helps gauge how the artwork might function within the social and historical context of the space. This research might be provided by a specific user group, long-time residents, facility staff, or the Austin History Center. Artists often use this information to identify connections that they might explore through art. They also learn what elements would not be appropriate for the site or context.

During the design phase, the selected artist receives input and feedback at various points that help inform how the artwork will meet established project goals. The proposed artwork is reviewed informally by the project team and stakeholders at preliminary and mid-design points, with public meetings scheduled as appropriate to gather community input. This might take place through public display boards, community meetings, information on ATXN or Speak Up Austin, open houses, artist lectures, or similar activities. The artist presents mid-design and final design concepts to the Art in Public Places Panel and other related Boards and Commissions at their public meetings, to receive additional input or approvals to move forward with the artwork design and fabrication stages.

Depending on the particular artistic approach to the project, there may be significant public input or interaction prior to an artist's final design approval. In some cases, artists have chosen to work with community members, schools, or after-school programs. Several AIPP projects have involved social practice, community volunteers, and public feedback as an integral part of the design process or the concept itself. Some examples:

- [Wall of Hands](#), Tre Arenz (500 handmade ceramic tiles clad the walls at either side of the entrance to the St. Elmo Service Center, a facility of Austin Energy. The tiles were made from plaster molds taken of the hands of community residents and St. Elmo Service Center employees.)
- [Spirit of Hope](#), David Newton (commemorative sculpture and fountain for the Millennium Youth Entertainment Center, which was built to provide neighborhood youth with safe entertainment options, in response to a 1992 drive-by shooting of a teenager. A poem by Michael Gifford, Jr., mounted near the sculpture, was selected through a neighborhood youth poetry contest about youth violence.)
- [Uprooted Dreams](#), Margarita Cabrera (sculptural installation created for the Mexican-American Cultural Center in collaboration with Austin's Latino immigrant community. The artist invited two artisans from Oaxaca, Mexico, to teach community members the carving and painting tradition of *alebrije* in a month-long workshop series.)
- [Deep Eddy Pool Mural Project](#), Wanda Montemayor and Lisa Orr (community-based tile mural to highlight the colorful history of Deep Eddy Pool, the oldest swimming pool in Texas. Artists worked with the Austin History Center and thousands of local teachers, students, non-profits, and volunteers to create the mural.)
- [North Austin Community Garden](#), Thoughtbarn (community garden designed and created by artists in collaboration with the YMCA of Austin, Sustainable Food Center, the City's Sustainable Urban Agriculture and Community Gardens Program, and others, which has been transferred over to the YMCA's Garden Leadership Group to program, operate, and expand in future phases)

Diversity of Art in Public Places Selection Panels

Since its inception, the Art in Public Places program has been committed to the diversity of the visual art and design professionals selected to recommend artists for commission based on gender, ethnicity, geography, and level/types of experience. However, there has been no quantitative measurement of the specific ethnic backgrounds as self-identified by these selection panelists.

As was pointed out by Council Member Houston and others on the dais, it is becomingly increasingly important to examine how to track and measure our commitment to diversity. Accordingly, program staff will soon implement a new questionnaire for all selection panel candidates that requests information related to gender, ethnicity, geography, and levels/types of experience. A corresponding database is currently in development that will assist staff in collecting these metrics, using them to recommend future selection panels that represent a full range of diversity, and provide program reports going forward.

The Art in Public Places program prides itself on a diverse public art collection, and agrees that diverse selection panels are crucial in helping to ensure the City is doing its best to meet this important programmatic goal.

Art in Public Places Artist Professional Development and Training Opportunities

Art in Public Places encourages artists to make the leap from studio art to public art and to build their professional practice, and offers assistance in those areas. AIPP started the TEMPO program in 2009, which seeks to commission Austin artists for temporary, site-specific works and provide a “training ground” for artists interested in transitioning into the public realm. To date, 17 artists have been commissioned, and the program is set to launch its third TEMPO Call to Artists in spring 2015. Several past TEMPO artists have received successive permanent artwork commissions and awards as a result of the experience gained through this program.

Art in Public Places also offers professional development opportunities on a regular basis (workshops, lectures, webinars, guest speakers, Open Office Hours with staff, etc.) to help provide insight and boost skills. In 2014, the Cultural Arts Division partnered with the Mid-America Arts Alliance to offer “Artist Inc.,” an intensive 6-week professional development course to focus on areas such as accounting, marketing, law, small business operations, networking, etc., and plans to offer it again in 2015.
