Technical Subcommittee of the City of Austin Bicycle Advisory Committee met May 5, 2015 at One Texas Center, 505 Barton Springs Road, 5th floor, Suite 500. The purpose of the subcommittee was to provide the Bicycle Advisory Council with a prioritized list of bicycle related projects that were shovel ready as recommended projects to be funded through the Quarter Cent Tax Fund Program.
