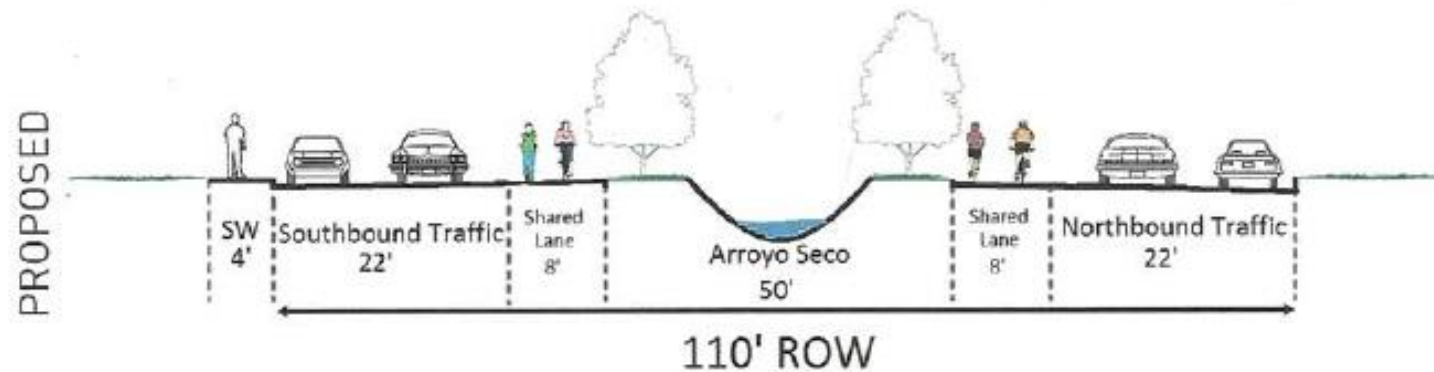
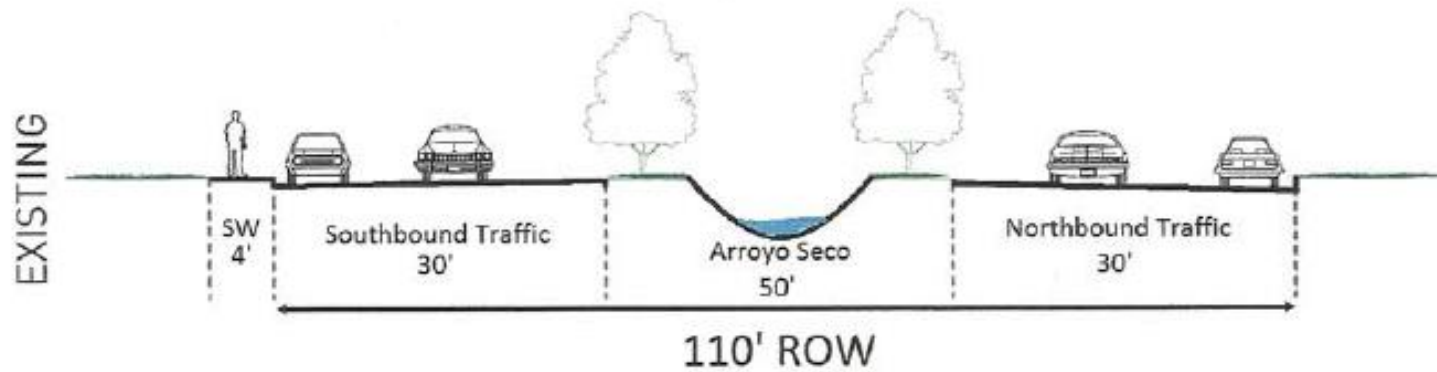

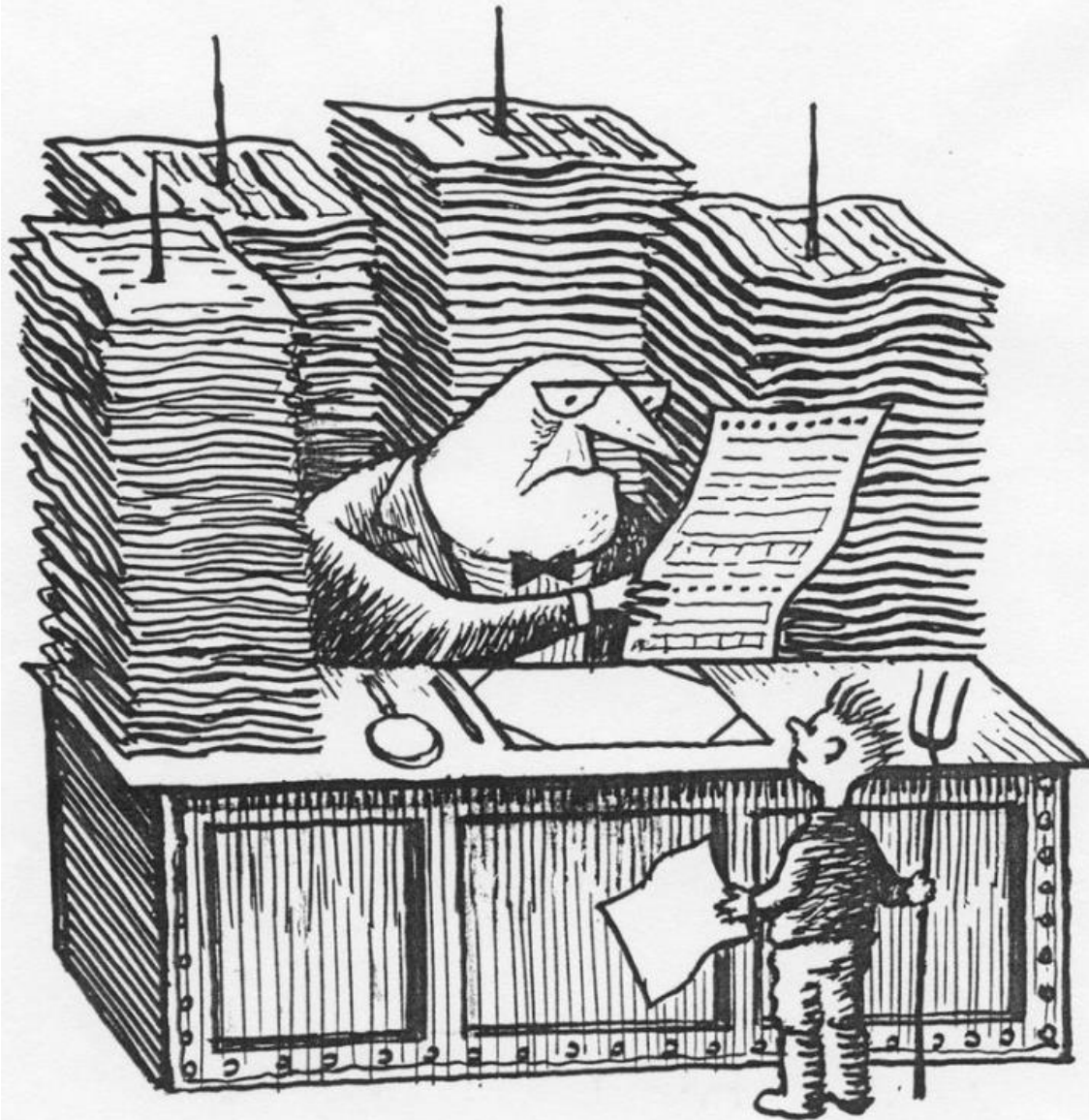
Arroyo Seco Protected Bike Lanes

Purpose:

Providing opportunities for community and neighborhood organizations to affect public improvements by sharing in the costs of those efforts with the City of Austin government

Community groups can apply to the City to “cost-share” on a wide variety of projects. Cost-share can be achieved through:

- Cash contributions
- Fair market value of donated goods/services
- Cost of donated materials
- “Sweat equity”
- A combination of the above

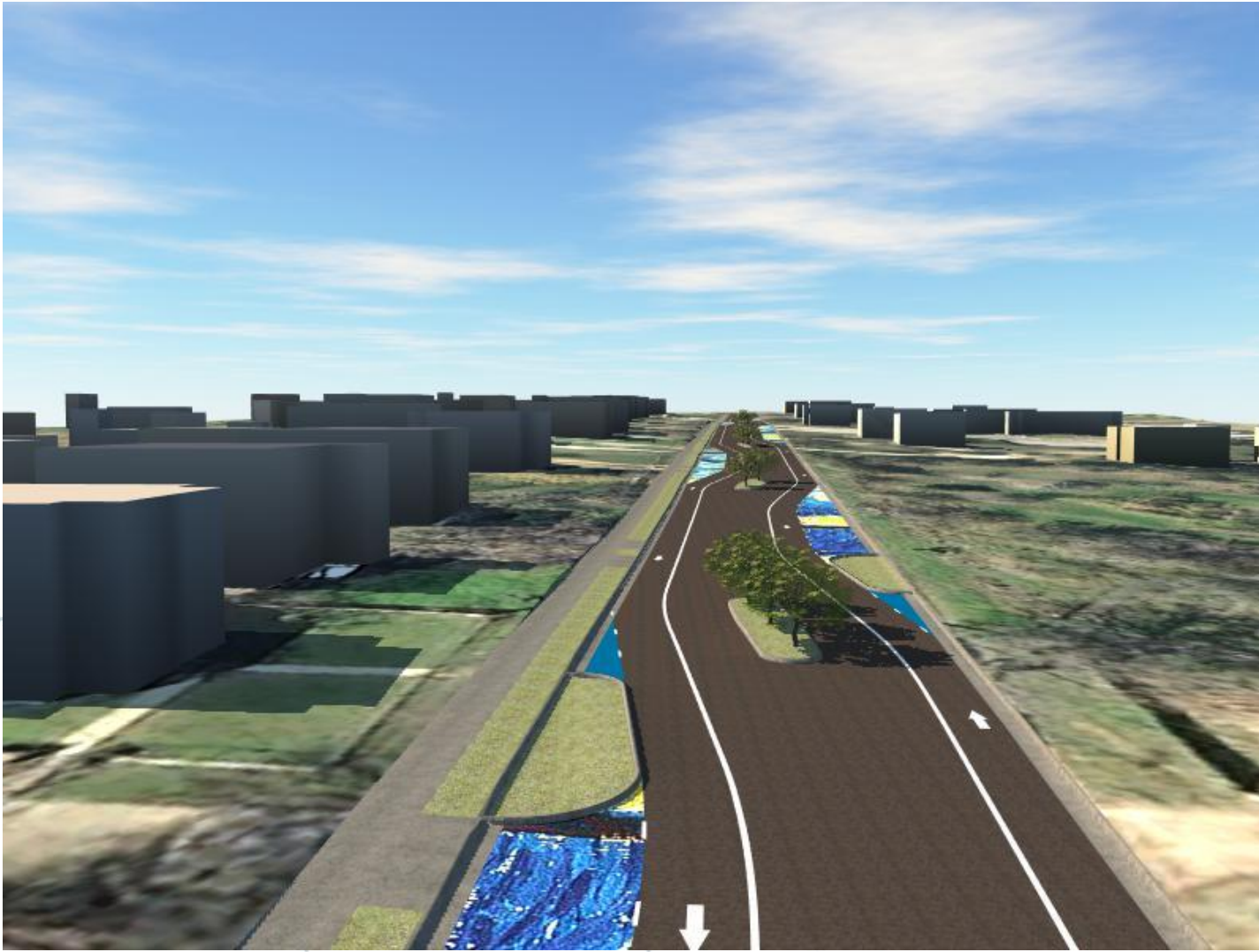

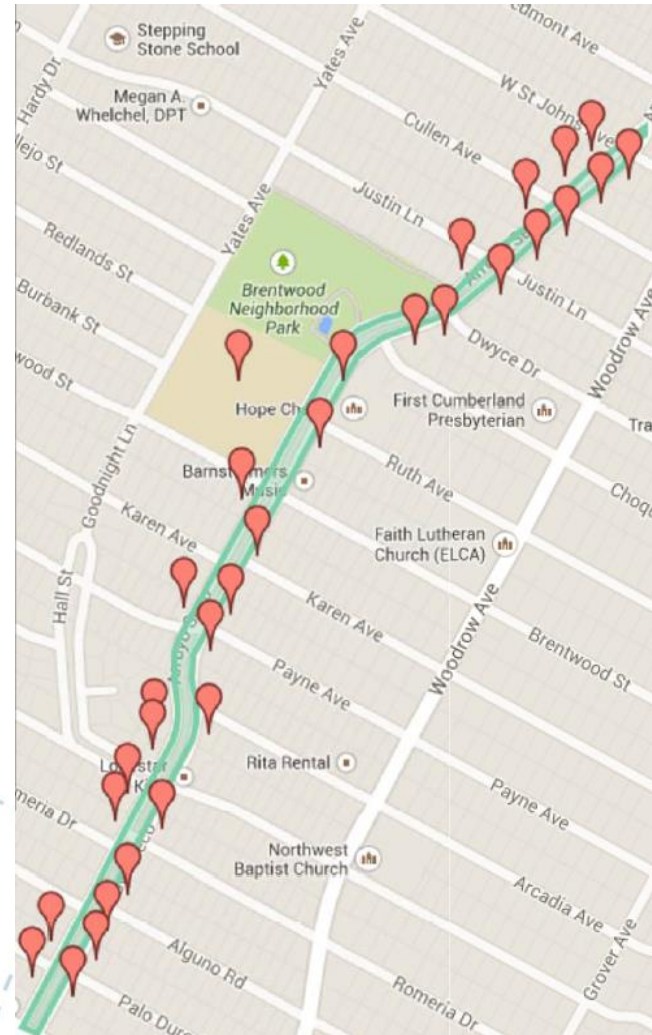

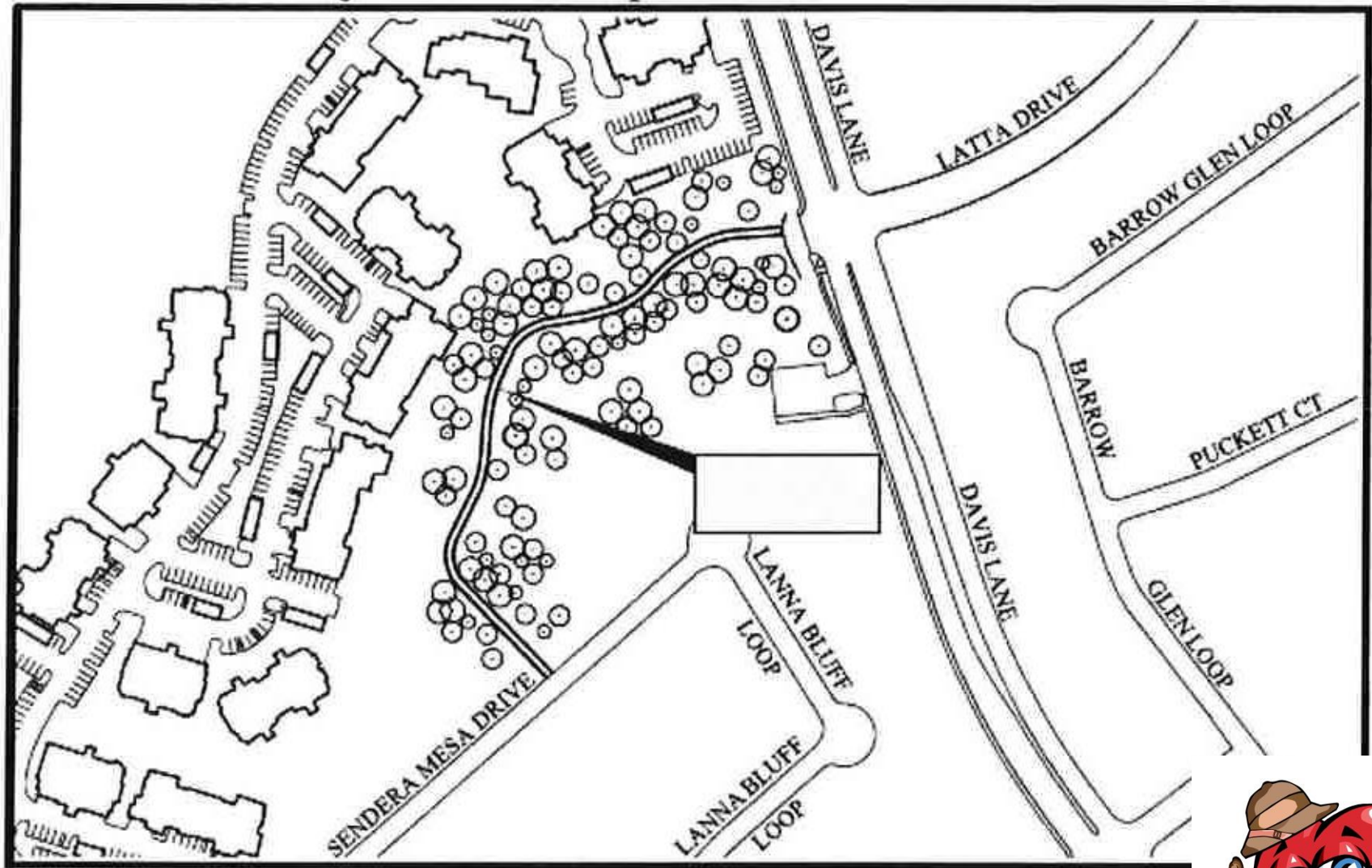
Criteria

- **Project is submitted by a community group:**
- **60% of impacted stakeholders must approve of the project.**
- **Proposed Project is on City property or Right-Of-Way**
- **Community Group maintains the project for the life of the project.**

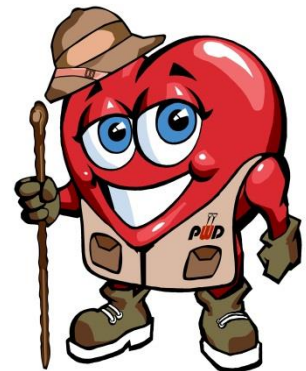


Project

Davis Lane Trail Segment






Ramsey Park Pathways and Stage

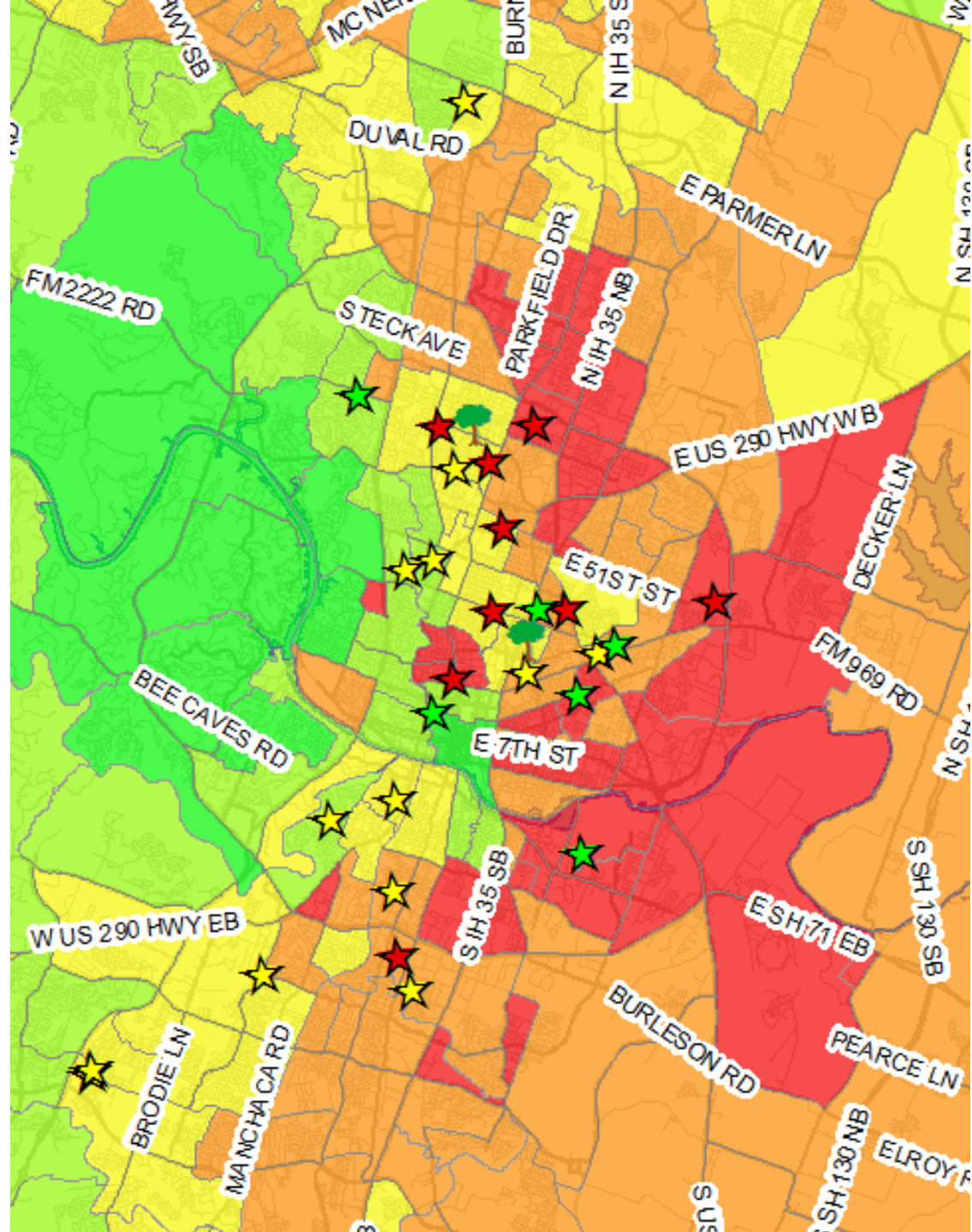


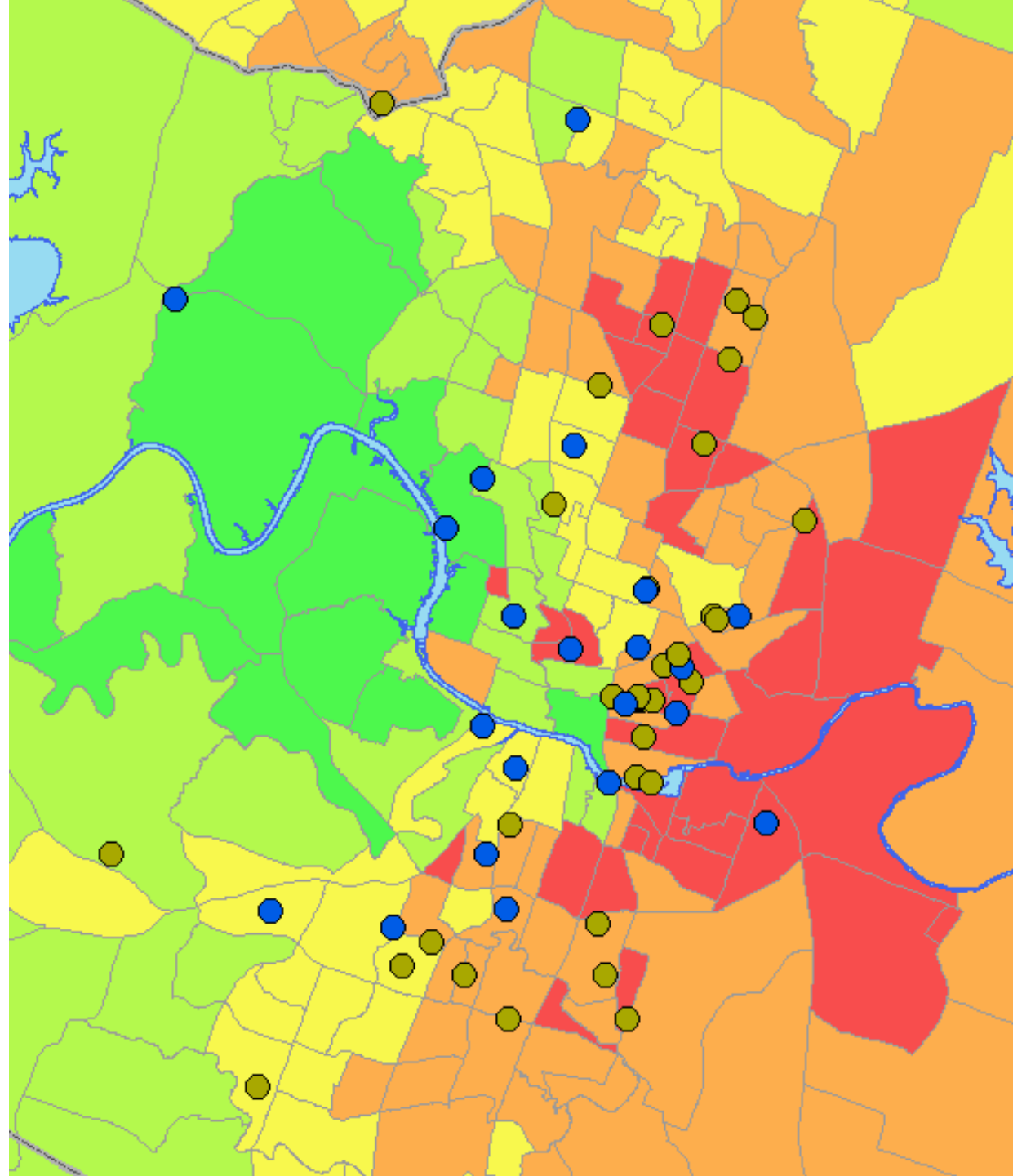
