Additional Backup Information

This action will expand the Austin Downtown Public Improvement District (PID) by one parcel of land, as requested by the property owner. Chapter 372 of the Texas Local Government Code requires that the governing body of the municipality hold a public hearing on the advisability of the expansion.

Under the Green Water Treatment Plant Master Development Agreement between the City of Austin and TC Green Water Master Development, LLC, the developer agreed to voluntarily request to become part of the PID and pay applicable assessments to benefit the PID. The property, contiguous to the current PID boundary, is bordered by the extension of Second Street alley on the north.
