Motion made by Board Member Brown, Seconded by Board Member Brewer to approve the \$30,000 soil amending grant with the stipulation that it only be applied toward trees where it's determined that a full ½ CRZ soil amendment can be done to minimum of 6 inch depth, incorporating compost and top dressing of mulch. Board Chair Kite, Board Vice-Chair Peggy Maceo, and Board Members Brewer, and Classen in favor. Board Members Fleming and Newsom absent. Motion carries.

- 2. Discussion and approval of grant application requesting \$30,000.00 for invasive plant management on the Shoal Creek Restoration Project. Board Chair Kite, Board Vice-Chair Maceo and Board Members, Brewer, Brown and Classen approved. Board Members Fleming and Newsom absent. Motion carries. Motion made by Board Vice-Chair Maceo, Seconded by Board Member Brown to approve the Urban Forestry Board Recommendations to the Zilker Park/Cyclo Cross Tree Remediation Contract as prepared and presented by Board Vice Chair Maceo. Motion amended by Board Vice-Chair Maceo, Seconded by Board Member Brown to include changes to recommendation numbers 7 and 8 as presented. Board Chair Kite, Board Vice-Chair Maceo and Board Members Brown and Classen approved. Board Members Fleming and Newsom absent. Board Member Brewer recused. Motion carries.

Recommendation

- 1. All tree remediation work shall meet requirement for Public Tree Care Work. Work to be done per ANSI 300 specs, and submit a Public Tree Care Permit.
- 2. Work plan will be reviewed on site prior to starting the work and will be supervised by PARD Forestry. A single point of contact at Forestry will be provided.
- 3. Certified Arborist is required to have ISA certification and at least 5 years' experience in doing soil aerations with an air spade.
- 4. Certified Arborist and other contractors for tree care will have to be approved by the City Arborist and Forestry.
- 5. Soil aerate all of the actual compacted area, not just percentages on list. All trees that were affected shall be treated.
- 6. Some damaged trees are missing from map. Three additional Cedar Elms in rock garden area.
- 7. Trees aerated will be monitored for health periodically for 2-5 years after soil aerations, by City staff and added to tree monitor list for yearly inspections.
- 8. Cut completely severed roots cleanly. Roots not completely severed should be left.
- 9. Apply organic compost to aerated area completely to achieve total percentage of 20%-25% compost.
- 10. No Dillo Dirt for compost.
- 11. All compacted soil shall be aerated. 6-inch minimum, deeper if needed.
- 12. One drenching cycle immediately after the soil aeration.
