WHEREAS, Larry Monroe was an inventive radio artist who created radio programs including the award-winning Blue Monday, the Phil Music Program, and Texas Radio Live; and

WHEREAS, Larry Monroe was known as "Master of the Segway" for his ability to sequence songs thematically to tell a story and known as well for his in-depth radio tributes honoring countless musicians; and

WHEREAS, Larry Monroe was tireless in his promotion of Austin and Texas songwriters; and

WHEREAS, on December 8, 2014, the Austin Arts Commission unanimously approved the Larry Monroe Forever Bridge project, which will install a mosaic artwork on a bridge located near where Larry Monroe once lived; and

WHEREAS, the Austin City Council is pleased to join friends, fans, and family in recognizing Larry Monroe's rich broadcasting legacy; **NOW, THEREFORE,**
