PROPOSAL

Demolish a ca. 1951 house.

ARCHITECTURE

One-story, rectangular-plan, stone-veneered frame house with a partial-width, shed-roofed, independent porch on ornamental metal posts; combination of 2:2 horizontally-configured sash windows and multi-light casement windows, with a fixed-sash picture window in the front flanked by multi-light casements; attached 2-bay frame garage.

RESEARCH

The house was built in 1951 by Cecil and Hazel Lock, who lived here until around 1991. Cecil Lock was a city firefighter, who worked his way up to the position of captain the fire department. He was the son of Tony Lock, a prominent deputy in Austin for many years. Hazel Lock worked as a clerk at the telephone company.


STAFF COMMENTS

The house does not appear in any City survey.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Encourage adaptive re-use and rehabilitation of the house, as it is a nice example of a post-war ranch house in this South Austin neighborhood. While the house does not have the requisite architectural nor historical significance to warrant individual landmark designation, it is representative of its era of building and the style of the neighborhood, and every consideration should be given to preserving and re-using this house. If the Commission votes to release the permit, then staff recommends completion of a City of Austin Documentation Package, consisting of photographs of all elevations, a dimensioned sketch plan, and a narrative history, for archiving at the Austin History Center.

Cecil W. and Hazel Lock (ca. 1951 – ca. 1991)

Cecil W. and Hazel Lock appear in the 1940 U.S. Census as the renters of the house at 4502 Avenue F in Austin. Cecil W. Lock was 28, had been born in Texas, and was an attendant at a service station. Hazel M. Lock was 27, had been born in Texas, and was an operator at the telephone company. They had no children listed with them.

The 1930 U.S. Census shows Cecil Lock as the 18-year old son of Tony and Trudy Lock, who owned their home at 1215 Canterbury Street. Cecil had no occupation listed; his father was a city deputy.

Cecil W. Lock, 79, of Austin passed away Tuesday.

Mr. Lock was a firefighter in Austin for over 31 years. He was a member of the Ward Memorial United Methodist Church for over 50 years. Cecil was a veteran of World War II, having served in the US Air Force, and was a member of the DAV.

He was preceded in death by his brother, T.P. Lock, Jr.; and sister, Beatrice Prather.
