Background Information: Funding of \$300,000 will fund a modest effort to provide outreach, education, and enrollment services targeted at the City's uninsured at 100% to \$250 of the Federal Poverty Level. Prior to 2015 no navigators were financed by the Federal government, the City of Austin, or Travis County. This item was granted one-time funding for FY2015.
