**ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:** The additional \$8,177 grant funds will be used to improve regional public health and medical emergency preparedness planning and response in Austin/Travis County by providing travel, training, supplies and other contractuals and commodities associated with grant administration and to support grant staff. The requested increase of \$8,177 represents the difference between the initial amended grant appropriation of \$682,177 and the current amended grant appropriation of \$674,000. When the grant funds expire, the Health and Human Services Department's need for continuing funding will be evaluated and may be denied.
