**ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:** This additional grant funding brings the total grant award to \$405,077 to help improve quality of life and reduce the years of potential life lost due to preventable conditions. The requested increase of \$55,077 represents the difference between the initial amended grant appropriation of \$405,077 and the current amended grant appropriation of \$350,000. A City match is not required. The General Fund will not be required to contribute additional funds beyond those currently budgeted to this grant. When the grant funds expire, the Health and Human Services Department's need for continuing funding will be evaluated and may be denied.
