### Purpose

- Council approved a new drainage charge methodology June 25
- Staff has been developing information needed to determine the unique charge for each individual parcel and is revising the billing system
- The City has approximately 200,000 parcels, and many have more than one owner
- Staff needs decisions on a couple of critical items to prepare the billing process and inform the public

### **Fee Ordinance Components**

Only two items are required for the drainage charge fee schedule:

- The base rate –produces revenues to match the budget
- The adjustment factor applies to all properties to reflect impacts of <u>percent</u> impervious cover (no impact on base rate)


### **Fee Ordinance Decisions**

- A percent reduction (phase-in cap)
   on any fee increases for single family
   residential properties, 1<sup>st</sup> year only
- Retain or eliminate any non-statemandated exemptions

### Monthly Single Family Charges with 50% Cap on Increase


Properties with largest impervious cover benefit the most

AF1, BR = 0.00500, BR with cap = 0.00524



### **50% Reduction of Single Family Fee Increases**

A 5% increase in the base rate for all properties is needed to recover \$4.2M lost revenue



# Drainage Charge Exemptions Texas Local Government Code

- Section 580.003 City must exempt:
  - State agencies
  - Institutions of higher education
- Section 552.053 City may exempt:
  - Counties
  - School districts
  - Religious organizations that are tax exempt


### County, School Districts, and Religious Exemptions

- Eliminating these exemptions would add:
  - 56.6 million sq. ft. of impervious cover
  - 473 parcels
  - Approximately \$2,830,000 annually
  - Allows for 4% decreased base rate


# County, School Districts, and Religious Exemptions

Entity	Estimated Annual Charge
County	\$230,000
School Districts	\$1,800,000
Religious	\$800,000
Total	\$2,830,000

### **Updated Fee Ordinance Components**

The base rate (BR) and the adjustment factor (AF) may be recalculated every year.


The most recent calculation yields (assuming no phase-in and no change to existing exemptions):

BR=0.00476 per square feet per month

AF= 1.5425 (%IC) +0.1933

### Recommendations

 Staff recommends no Phase-in for single family drainage charge increases

 Staff recommends continuing the existing drainage charge exemptions
