Additional Backup Information

A request has been received for the aerial encroachment of the East 7th Street right-of-way and San Marcos Street right-of-way. The proposed encroachments will include balconies and roof overhangs which are features of a planned hotel to be located at the northwest corner of San Marcos Street and the East 7th Street intersection. The encroachments will be behind the curb.

This application requires Council's consideration and approval before the applicant can secure a site plan permit, which is a condition of securing the applicant's construction loan. Postponement in considering this request will delay the applicant's ability to proceed with construction.

The appraised value of the encroachment is \$26,619. A check in the amount of the appraised value has been submitted to the Office of Real Estate Services for processing upon approval of this encroachment application.

Per the requirement established in Ordinance No. 20130822-027, the applicant has submitted a check in the amount of \$3,500 to reimburse the City for the cost of the appraisal.

As required by City Code Section 14-11-54, public notices were sent by certified mail, return receipt requested, to registered neighborhood associations whose boundaries include the area of proposed encroachment. No objections were received. The applicant has reimbursed the City for the cost associated for these notices, as required by City Code, in the amount of \$123.12.
