Additional Backup Information

The Martin Hill Transmission Main Segment A, Segment B, and Segment C Project constructed a new 17,500-linear-long 54-inch diameter water line from the Martin Hill Reservoir to the intersections of McNeil Drive and Parmer Lane. A portion of this new water line installed in the westbound lanes of McNeil Drive from Howard Lane to Parmer Lane.

In November 2011, during the design phase of the project, Travis County requested that the Project provide additional pavement repairs beyond the standard pavement repair criteria of the City of Austin, to include the eastbound lanes on McNeil Drive. The City requested that Travis County commit to an agreement to cost-share the added expense of the pavement repairs. It was agreed that City would cover 75 percent and Travis County would cover 25 percent of the cost of the additional pavement repair for the eastbound lanes on McNeil Drive based on the unit bid cost for the work included in the project contract.

The interlocal agreement will provide that Travis County will reimburse the City for the costs of the County's portion of the additional pavement repair.

The project location is within Council District 6.

This project is managed by the Public Works Department.
