Background: Ordinance Changes Approved

June 25, 2015 - City Council approved changes to how the drainage charge is calculated.

- Effective date is Oct. 1st
- First bills mailed Nov. 1st

Drainage Charge Revision

Primarily based on development impact with two parameters:

- Amount of impervious area (square feet)
- Percentage of impervious area

3,000 ft² Impervious 5,000 ft² Lot



New Method of Calculation Same for all properties


Monthly charge = monthly base rate x sq. ft. of impervious area x an adjustment factor for the percentage impervious area

Fee Ordinance Components

- The base rate –produces revenues to match the budget
- The adjustment factor –reflects impacts of percent impervious area
- A percent reduction (phase-in) on fee increases for single family residential properties, 1st year only
- A percent reduction for Customer Assistance program (CAP)

Monthly Single Family Charges with 50% Cap on Increase

Base Rate w/o reduction = \$0.00476 sf IC/month, with reduction = \$0.005 sf IC/month



FY 15 -16 Fee Ordinance

- Base rate = \$0.005/ft²/IA/month
 (\$0.06/ft²/year in the fee ordinance)
- Adjustment Factor = 1.5425 (%IC) +0.1933
- Phase-in % on increases: = 50% reduction
 first year, on single family only
- Customer Assistance Program (CAP): 50%
 reduction (for 12,500 residential properties)
