Significant building shall be defined as recreation, senior, cultural centers or other significant destination facilities used for parks and recreational purposes.

22 23 24 25	(A) A facility may be named for a deceased individual only if the deceased individual has provided a valuable contribution and creditable service to the park system, the City, and has been deceased for a minimum of 2 years. A park can only be named after a living person if they comply with 14-1-36 of this Article.					
26	(B) A facility named for an individual may not be renamed.

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- (3) for park facilities greater than 30 acres and up to 200 acres in size, the lesser of 600 signatures representing households or property owners within a 2-mile radius of the park facility or signatures representing at least 75% of the households or property owners within a 2-mile radius of the park facility; or
- (4) for greenbelts and park facilities greater than 200 acres in size, 1,000 signatures representing households or property owners within the city limits.
- (C) In order to be counted under this section, a signature must be accompanied by the legible name and address of the signator.
- (D) The council may by resolution establish different criteria and procedures for the naming of a particular park facility. If a park facility is partially funded by another entity, the council shall consider that entity's concerns in naming the facility.
