

1 (C) A non-refundable application fee must be paid at the time of submission of the
2 application.

3 (D) A sign fabrication and installation fee must be paid prior to fabrication.

4 (E) In addition to the other requirements of this Article, naming or renaming a park
5 facility must also comply with the requirements of Section 14-1-36 (Additional
6 Requirements for Naming or Renaming Park Facility).

7
8 **PART 3.** Chapter 14-1 (*Dedication of or Naming of a Public Facility or Property*) of the
9 City Code is amended to add a new Section 14-1-36 to read:

10 **§ 14-1-36 ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR NAMING OR RENAMING**
11 **PARK FACILITY.**

12 (A) A park facility may be named for:

- 13 (1) a person or group that deeds the land for the park facility;
14 (2) a person or group that contributes the anticipated cost of 50% of the
15 development of park facility and
16 (3) provides an endowment for the anticipated 20-year maintenance costs of the
17 park facility; or
18 (4) a person or subject of community significance including a historic figure; an
19 event or concept; a local, state, or national leader; or an individual or group
20 that has made exceptional contributions to the betterment of the community
21 or the park system.

22 (B) Suggestions made on the basis of community support shall be accompanied by the
23 following:

- 24 (1) for park facilities less than 2 acres in size, the lesser of 200 signatures
25 representing households or property owners within a 0.25-mile radius of the
26 park facility or signatures representing at least 75% of the households or
27 property owners within a 0.25-mile radius of the park facility;
28 (2) for park facilities from 2 to 30 acres in size, the lesser of 200 signatures
29 representing households or property owners within a 0.50-mile radius of the
30 park facility or signatures representing at least 75% of the households or
31 property owners within a 0.50-mile radius of the park facility;

1 (3) for park facilities greater than 30 acres and up to 200 acres in size, the lesser
2 of 600 signatures representing households or property owners within a 2-
3 mile radius of the park facility or signatures representing at least 75% of the
4 households or property owners within a 2-mile radius of the park facility; or

5 (4) for greenbelts and park facilities greater than 200 acres in size, 1,000
6 signatures representing households or property owners within the city limits.

7 (C) In order to be counted under this section, a signature must be accompanied by the
8 legible name and address of the signator.

9 (D) The council may by resolution establish different criteria and procedures for the
10 naming of a particular park facility. If a park facility is partially funded by another
11 entity, the council shall consider that entity's concerns in naming the facility.
