Date: September 15, 2015

Subject: Authorize execution of power purchase agreements with one or more qualified

offerors for 200 to 275 megawatts of utility-scale, solar-generated electricity, in an estimated amount of \$22,500,000 to \$31,000,000 per year, and a total estimated amount of \$445,000,000 to \$620,000,000 with contract terms ranging

between 15 and 25 years.

Recommendation

The Resource Management Commission unanimously recommends approval of the power purchase agreements with two caveats.

Description of Recommendation to Council

The Resource Management Commission unanimously recommends approval of the power purchase agreements with the following notes:

- 1. Austin Energy should request confirmation from the Center for Resource Solutions, the organization who administers the Green-e program and that certifies Austin Energy's GreenChoice program, that the utility is allowed to use solar generated from this purchase in its GreenChoice program.
- 2. Support for this power purchase agreement does not preclude additional solar purchases that may result from the recent RFP.
