On December 11, 2014, City Council passed Resolution No. 20141211-219. It initiated amendments to City Code Chapter 25-1, Article 14 ( <i>Parkland Dediation</i> ) to address issues related to fee inadequacy raised in the Parkland Dedication Fee Methodology Report (Report) of November 19, 2014.						
The Report, initiated by the City Manager and written by Parks and Recreation Department staff, concluded that the existing parkland dedication (PLD) fee does not cover costs for acquiring and developing parkland and the current						

The City Manager was directed to return to City Council with a draft ordinance to gather stakeholder input and implement the Report's recommendations. Five stakeholder meetings were held from October 2014 through January 2015 and public input was incorporated into the draft ordinance.
