The contract is for the management and operation of the Austin Tennis Center, the City's newest tennis facility built in December 2008. Located at 7800 Johnny Morris Road, Austin Tennis Center has 10 lighted courts, eight lighted quick-start courts, one lighted backboard, and a 200 square foot pro-shop. The City will pay the contractor a monthly management fee; the contractor will collect court fees, manage court reservations, offer tennis programming, and provide other related services.

Austin Tennis Center also provides physical education services to Austin Independent School District (AISD) students through an interlocal agreement.

The evaluation team, consisting of Parks and Recreation Department personnel with expertise in this area, scored Lone Star Tennis Company's proposal as the best to manage and operate the tennis facility based on their operation and management practices, applicable experience, financial viability, and local business presence.

The current contract expires January 28, 2016. Without this contract, there will be a gap in tennis services provided to the northeastern region of the City. Since the tennis center also provides educational services to AISD, there would also be a negative impact on AISD's educational programs.
