This project is for the installation of a new water line within the TXDOT Roadway and is design and managed by Travis County, along FM 1626 from Ranch Alto to Brodie Lane to improve the water quality and the water pressure in the area. This project is a Pass-Through Project. Under the Pass-Through Agreement between Travis County and TXDOT, the County is responsible for providing engineering services for the project, and TXDOT is responsible for the construction phase of the project. The City of Austin and Travis County have agreed to include the design and construction of this adjustment in the Travis County contract.

This project requires the installation of approximately 2100 linear feet of 16" water line, approximately 23 linear feet of 6" waterline, 3 resilient seated 6" gate valves, 3 resilient seated 16" gate valves, 1 drain valve, and 3 fire hydrants. The city agrees to pay all costs including inclusion of the engineering design, inspection, and testing of the improvements and, agrees to reimburse Travis County construction costs of the improvements, including the cost of change orders made necessary by field changes to address unanticipated conditions under the terms and conditions in this agreement. Travis County shall obtain the written approval from the City for all change order requests prior to Travis County issuing the approved change order to the contractor.

A 10% contingency in funding has been included to allow for the expeditious processing of change orders that may result from the potential unknown surface condition and utility conflicts, when working within the right of way. All dates are dependent upon County design and construction contract.

This project is located within zip codes 78652 and 78748, within the 2 Mile Extraterritorial Jurisdiction managed by Austin Water (AWU).

This project is managed by Public Works Department.
