ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: This ordinance is not amending the Operating Budget of any department. This action details the estimated unrealized revenue resulting from this ordinance to address damage resulting from the flooding events that occurred during the week of October 30, 2015.

This item waives and reimburses permitting and development fees for damages resulting from the flood disaster. The unrealized revenue from the Development Services Department (DSD) is estimated at \$391,548. This estimate is based on 402 homes with flood water damages and an average of \$974 in permit and related fees per home. The breakdown for the \$974 per home is as follows:

Building permit: \$200
Electric permit: \$170
Plumbing permit: \$160
Mechanical permit: \$65
Plan review fee: \$342

Technology surcharge (4% of each permit/fee): \$37

The estimated permitting and development fees to address damage resulting from the week of October 30 flooding event were not anticipated and are not included in the FY 2015-16 Approved Budget. Therefore, the waiver of these fees represents unrealized revenue and does not impact the FY 2016 budgeted revenue. The unrealized revenue is solely an estimate based on this ordinance and subject to adjustment as additional information becomes available. This estimate will be monitored and updates will be provided to Council.
