- 2. (11/19) Authorize negotiation and execution of a contract with OXFORD ADVISORS, LLC, for an independent consumer advocate for residential and small commercial electric utility customers, in an amount not to exceed \$200,000.
- 3. (12/17) Authorize award and execution of a 24-month contract with TECHLINE PIPE LP, to provide manhole covers and rings, in an amount not to exceed \$176,702 with three 12-month extension options in an amount not to exceed \$88,351 per extension option, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$441,755.
- 4. (12/17) Authorize award and execution of a 24-month contract with SCHNEIDER ELECTRIC USA, INC., to provide relay retrofit assemblies, in an amount not to exceed \$175,860, with three 12-month extension options in an amount not to exceed \$87,930 per extension option, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$439,650.
