

BOARD/COMMISSION RECOMMENDATION

<u>Urban Transportation Commission</u>

Recommendation Number: 20151013-03C: Taxi Co-op

WHEREAS, the City of Austin continues to experience significant growth in population as a business and tourism destination; and

WHEREAS, such growth creates a greater demand for ground transportation for-hire services where there is currently unmet demand; and

WHEREAS, multiple business models are entering the Austin market to meet that demand; and

WHEREAS, the taxicab industry occupies a unique role in providing ground transportation forhire to all Austinites; and

WHEREAS, a driver-owned taxicab cooperative model would allow owner-operators the opportunity to compete in the ground transportation for-hire marketplace

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Urban Transportation Commission recommends to the City Council their support to the concept of the Taxi Co-op with 548 new permits.
