### 2. CITIZENS COMMUNICATION: GENERAL

Mr. Michael Fossum discussed the Austin Coyote Management Program that will affect our trails, parks and open spaces. Adopting the Animal Advisory Commission/Animal Chief Officer joint recommendations will increase the danger to citizens by aggressive coyotes, thereby limiting access to parks, trails and open spaces which are urban habitat for coyotes. It was asked that the UTC consider these recommendations and contact the City Council. No Action Taken.

# A. Parking Benefit District West Campus - Discussion and Possible Action

Mr. Steve Grassfield, Parking Enterprise Manager with the Austin Transportation Department discussed a proposed expansion of the University Area Partners Parking Benefit District in an effort to provide turnover and improve the availability of on street parking to business customers and visitors to the area.

# B. Corridor Studies - Briefing and Possible Action

Mr. Eric Bollich, Supervising Engineer with the Austin Transportation Department provided an update on the guiding principles; history; purpose and process. These updates included North Lamar Boulevard, Burnet Road, FM 969, Airport Boulevard, Riverside Drive /Lakeshore Boulevard, Guadalupe Street and South Lamar. No Action Taken.

# C. Vision Zero Update - Discussion and Possible Action

Mr. Frances Reilly, Planner with the Planning and Zoning Department provided an update on traffic deaths and injuries; safety; traffic safety solutions through education, enforcement,

prosecution, land use and transportation engineering; developing a media campaign and using the task force to continue multi-department and agency coordination. No Action Taken.

## D. 1/4 Cent - Discussion and Possible Action

Ms. Annick Beaudet, Program Consultant Planning Manager with the Austin Transportation Department and Ms. Annie Van Zant, Capital Program Manager with the Public Works Department discussed the purpose of the 1/4 Cent Fund; Capital Metro Transit Authority ½ Cent Fund Background; types of projects; Council briefings and coordination; 10 step development process; goals; mobility programs; travel demand management program; staff recommendations; grouped mobility projects around schools and the next steps.

Mr. Malcolm Yeatts asked the Urban Transportation Commission to use some of the ¼ Cent funds to fix the problems on Country Club Creek Trail in the Riverside Corridor. Ms. Sari Albornoz supports using ¼ Cent funds to fix the Boggy Creek Trail.

E. Transportation Management Center Contract - Discussion and Possible Action

Mr., Jim Dale, Assistant Director with the Austin Transportation Department discussed the Traffic Management Center's current and proposed operations staffing times; outsourcing benefits and monitoring special events. There was discussion of the Urban Transportation Commission taking a tour of the Traffic Management Center at a later date and time. No Action Taken.

#### F. TNC - Discussion and Possible Action

There was discussion from the Commissioners on the background checks; the resolution that is going to the Mobility Committee; what other cities are doing; TNC's providing their data reports; and equal regulations.

Mr. Ken Craig, Policy Aid with Council Member Ann Kitchen's Office, stated that an expert from DPS attended the last City Council Meeting and presented evidence from an Attorney General Study that a fingerprint or bio-metric identification process is accurate in over 99% of cases and a name check is around 88% accurate. Mr. Craig also stated that Public Safety is top priority when it comes to the residents and visitors of Austin.

Mr. Joseph Iley addressed his concerns about TNC's doing what they please and not be regulated. No Action Taken.
