What is a service plan?

- Transit agencies use service plans as a guide for system enhancements and expansion for the next 10 years.
- Every 5 years, Capital Metro updates what we call a service plan, or comprehensive operational analysis, that spans 10 years and guides the agency's 3 yearly service changes.
- It's 2015, and our service plan is due for an update since its last refresh in 2010.



Service Plan 2020 Successes

- Board adopted in February 2010 and most recommendations implemented over a 5 year period.
- Implemented the first transit priority lanes in Austin along Guadalupe and Lavaca.
- Launched the High-Frequency Route Network along five major routes.
- Realigned and extended routes to provide additional mobility options.
- · Eliminated poor performing routes.
- Launched MetroRapid Routes 801 & 803.





Capital Metro Current Initiatives


- Capital Metro is currently planning for several short-term service enhancements:
 - Expanded Park & Ride network planned to accommodate new south Austin express routes.
 - Express riders will also benefit when MoPac Express Lanes open in 2016, as transit vehicles will be able to bypass congestion, getting people to their destinations more quickly and reliably.
 - Adding parking spaces at the Lakeline and Howard Park & Rides to provide more capacity for MetroRail, MetroExpress and Local service customers.



Connections 2025: The challenge

You know as well as we do that Central Texas is bursting at the seams and will continue to experience explosive growth—it's the new norm. What's less in vogue is auto-dependency and the daily traffic we sit in (including our buses)!

Over the past two years, system-wide ridership has declined over 5%. We take this very seriously and we want to fully understand why.







Outlier: The Case of Austin's Declining African-American Population






