## Additional Backup Information

On October 1, 2015, the City Council initiated a code amendment to add oversight and compliance requirements for neighborhood plan contact teams. As directed by Council Resolution No. 20151001-045, staff scheduled stakeholder meetings and conducted an online survey to identify strengths and weaknesses of the existing contact team structure. Proposed amendments are intended to create transparency, inclusivity, and accountability of contact teams by setting minimum standards for bylaws and creating a process for dealing with complaints of non-compliance.
