Background: Roles

Council-appointed City Auditor:

 manages a fraud reporting hotline and conducts investigations of fraud, waste, or abuse

Council-appointed Ethics Review Commission:

Hears and rules on complaints alleging violations of various sections of City Code including code of ethics, campaign finance, lobbyists

City Council Audit and Finance Committee (per City Code):

provides assurance to the council that the City is in compliance with applicable law and regulation, conducting its affairs ethically, and maintaining effective internal controls against a conflict of interest or fraud

Procedural Changes: City Code 2-3

- Subject's right to representation
- Subject and involved parties ability to provide a response to the report prior to issuance
- Periodic reporting on investigations to the Audit and Finance Committee by the City Auditor and City Manager
- Processes for different types of employees/officials

Substantiated investigations would result in a complaint filed by the City Auditor to the Ethics Review Commission

Procedural Changes: City Code 2-7

- Fraud and abuse included in Code of Ethics
- Ethics Review Commission has jurisdiction over interference in personnel matters by City Council
- Processes for Ethics Review Commission to self-initiate complaints and receive complaints from the Auditor
- Complainant and respondent required to attend final hearing
- Ethics Review Commission has subpoend power for witnesses or information
- Ethics Review Commission can request investigative assistance from the City Auditor
