



- We will use Focus Areas to evaluate the impacts of potential new Code Standards on specific places around the city.
- Focus Areas were selected because:
  - They are representative of other areas in Austin with similar development patterns.
  - They allow us to address key questions, issues, and tradeoffs associated with the draft Code Standards.

Minor Corridor/Medium Node: Oltorf and South 1st

Major Center: Slaughter at Manchaca


Minor/Neighborhood Node:

Stassney and Nuckols Crossing 12th and Hargrave


Large Shopping Center Redevelopment: 183 and McNeil

Commercial Node/Urban Context: MLK between Chicon and Poquito



# Testing Type 4: Outside the Transect




