Ms. Myers is experienced in numerous aspects of historic preservation including cultural resources surveys, archival research, National Register nominations, Section 106 assessment, and preservation planning. The hallmarks of her business are Cultural Resources Surveys and National Register nominations. She began her career as Preservation Administrator for the city of Raleigh, North Carolina, where she developed and interpreted design guidelines for the city's historic districts and landmarks. Ms. Myers remains committed to the viability of historic districts and the use of design guidelines to direct appropriate rehabilitation and new construction within their boundaries. In Austin, Texas, she has conducted surveys, research, and completed applications for the city's first three Local Historic District applications.

Over her 30-year career as a historic preservation professional, Ms. Myers has documented more than 30,000 individual historic resources and has successfully nominated more than 7,000 properties to the National Register of Historic Places. Ms. Myers has specifically chosen projects that expand her knowledge of other cultures and their resources. Her work ranges from Spanish Colonial settlements in the El Paso (El Valle Bajo) and Rio Grande valleys (San Ygnacio NR, Barrio Azteca NR), to African American freedmen's colonies: From Creek Freedmen to Oklahoma Oil Men (1878-1929) and After Slavery: The Rubin Hancock Farmstead, 1880-1916. She has documented German and Alsatian landscapes, Blackland Prairie farms, Western ranches, Civil War battlefields, frontier forts, and numerous residential and commercial developments.

Ms. Myers has worked closely with local, state and federal agencies, including many county commissioners and SHPOs, various state departments of transportation, the U. S. Corps of Engineers, the U. S. Surface Transportation Board, the National Park Service, and many local communities. Her references are available upon request.
