The retention of the original form would keep the architectural integrity of the home intact. This house does have a potential Historic Landmark Designation due to its historic associations with both Phillip Creer as well as Mike Michalske. Changing the roof form and removing the original siding would compromise the architecturally integrity of the house and possibly prevent it from being designated as a Landmark.
