

SMALL AREA PLANNING JOINT COMMITTEE PLANNING COMMISSION/ZAP REGULAR MEETING MINUTES WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 9, 2015

Chair Jean Stevens called the meeting to order at 6:30 P.M.

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

a. Approval of minutes from the November 4th, 2015 meeting – Commissioner White moved to approve the minutes from the November 4, 2015 regular meeting, with a second

3. OLD BUSINESS

a. Mark Walters presented. It was recommended that Greg Guernsey and a representative from legal be present at the next meeting. Staff was directed to come back with an outreach strategy, previous analysis with Envision Tomorrow and current analysis with CodeNext.
