ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: Austin Resource Recovery (ARR) is actively pursuing the development of its [re]Manufacturing Hub project. In order to complete remaining design requirements and begin construction, it requires the use of cash funding as opposed to debt. In addition, proceeds from the land sale will assist the Department in funding the future Northeast Service Facility located on Johnny Morris Rd (District 1).

Due to the sale of the land known as 4711 Winnebago Lane (District 2) and long-term lease of the land known as 4712 Bolm Road (District 2), ARR has additional cash funding available to support its facility development and construction efforts. This Council action will recognize the revenue from these two real estate transactions and enable the department to increase transfers out to its capital budget. The capital appropriations will support the previously mentioned [re]Manufacturing Hub project and any remaining funds will support other future facility needs.
