WHEREAS, on November 30, 2015, the Public Safety Committee of the City Council heard a presentation regarding the potential benefits of amending the City of Austin's sign regulations to allow digital billboards; and

WHEREAS, after considering the briefing, the Public Safety Committee voted to forward to the City Council, without recommendation, an item to initiate amendments to the City's sign regulations; NOW, THEREFORE,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

- 1. The City Council initiates amendments to City Code Chapter 25-10 (Sign Regulations) and directs the City Manager to develop a proposed ordinance to allow digital signage and make related changes to existing sign regulations as deemed to appropriate.
- 2. The ordinance should be presented to Council for consideration within a reasonable time 120 days from adopted date, following required review by the Planning Commission and such other review as may be deemed appropriate.
- 3. Prior to the presentation of an ordinance to Council, the City Manager is directed to conduct a series of stakeholder meetings to ascertain public support.
