PART 1. Chapter 2-1 (City Boards) of the 146 to read as follows:	City Code is amended by adding section 2-1-
§ 2-1-146 HISPANIC/LATINO QUALITY OF LIFE RESOURCE ADVISORY COMMISSION.	
 (A) The Hispanic/Latino Quality of Life Resource Advisory Commission should have a balanced membership reflecting in-depth knowledge of the challenges and concerns of the Hispanic/Latino community. The City Council should appoint persons who are representative of or sensitive to the needs of the Hispanic/Latino community in the City of Austin. (B) The commission shall advise the City Council on issues relating to the quality of life for the City's Hispanic/Latino community and shall recommend programs and policies designed to alleviate any inequities that may confront Hispanics and Latinos in social, economic, and vocational pursuits including education, youth services, housing and community development, cultural arts, economic development, health, civic engagement, and transportation.
