- PARD approached in January of 2015 by the founder of Notes for Notes regarding recording studio/programming partnership
- Notes for Notes is a 501(c)3 non profit organization
  - Designs equips and staffs after-school recording studios
  - Offering youth (6-18yrs) the opportunity to explore, create, and record music, FREE of charge
  - Professional instruments guitars, basses, drums, keyboards and other equipment – provided
  - DJ gear, digital music workstations and a full recording facilities
  - Provides education for youth on careers both on the stage and behind the scenes

- PARD is currently exploring entering into a Service Agreement with Notes for Notes for Doris Miller Auditorium
- Notes for Notes toured 3 PARD locations
- Doris Miller Auditorium was selected based on the following criteria:
  - Underutilized programming space
  - Historical use of facility
  - Location



# Notes For Notes – Recording Studio Commitment Recommendations

- City of Austin Commitment
  - Location Doris Miller
  - Initial term of 5 years
  - Provide receptionist services normally provided at the location
  - Make kitchen and meeting space available to Notes for Notes staff
  - Janitorial services and utilities
  - Initial contraction of studio space
- Notes for Notes Commitment
  - Operate the recording studio
  - Provide all equipment and instruments
  - Adequately staff the recording facility as deemed necessary
  - Acquire national recording artist to visit location and meet with participants
  - Conduct Background Checks on recording studio staff
  - Operate the studio during out of school hours in which the City operates its programs for youth.
  - Typical studio hours M-F 3pm 7pm (some weekends, special events, home schools and school class visits)
  - Anticipate serving 700 participants/year with 200 of those being frequent participants (weekly and monthly).
  - Open to working with established local artist and producers

- PARD Investment
  - Estimated Construction Cost's of \$50,000
  - Funding available through Parkland Dedication
  - No Annual Operating Cost's
- Notes for Notes Cost
  - Estimated Equipment Cost's of \$45,000
  - Annual Operating Cost's of \$75,000
    - Full Time Regional Director
    - Insurance
    - National Management
    - Program Supplies and Equipment Maintenance
