## ORDINANCE NO. 20160225-063

## AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A SITE-SPECIFIC AMENDMENT TO SECTION 25-8-514 OF THE CITY CODE AND VARIANCES TO SECTIONS 25-8-261 AND 25-8-482 OF THE CITY CODE TO ALLOW REDEVELOPMENT OF THE SAINT CATHERINE OF SIENA CHURCH.

## **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

**PART 1.** The site-specific code amendment and variances granted in this ordinance apply to the St. Catherine of Siena Church redevelopment project as proposed in and subject to Site Plan Number SP 2014-0476C.

#### PART 2. IMPERVIOUS COVER, WATER QUALITY CONTROLS.

City Code Section 25-8-514 (Pollution Prevention Required) is amended to:

- (1) allow impervious cover in excess of 15%, and
- (2) allow runoff from the development to be managed through water quality controls that comply with Section 25-8-213 (*Water Quality Control Standards*) or are approved under Section 25-8-151 (*Innovative Management Practices*) and treat the redeveloped area.

#### PART 3. CRITICAL WATER QUALITY ZONE, TRANSITION ZONE

A variance is granted from City Code Section 25-8-261 (*Critical Water Quality Zone Development*) and City Code Section 25-8-514 (*Pollution Prevention Required*) is amended to allow construction of on-site water quality controls in the critical water quality zone.

A variance is granted from City Code Section 25-8-261 (*Critical Water Quality Zone Development*) to allow a hard surfaced trail less than 150 feet from the centerline of a major waterway.

A variance is granted from City Code Section 25-8-482 (*Water Quality Transition Zone*) to allow development within the water quality transition zone.

#### PART 4. CONDITIONS.

Construction of the St. Catherine of Siena Church redevelopment project authorized by this ordinance must adhere to the following conditions:

- (1) Water quality controls shall achieve the minimum pollutant load reductions as specified in the attached and incorporated **EXHIBIT A**;
- (2) Total impervious cover on the site shall not exceed 202,717 square feet; and
- (3) Development in the critical water quality zone is limited to the water quality controls and hard surfaced trail for which variances and an amendment is granted in Part 3 of this Ordinance.

The City may not release Site Plan Number SP 2014-0476C until the applicant has mitigated for the impervious cover allowed under the amendment in Part 2 of this Ordinance by paying \$386,592 into the Barton Springs Zone Mitigation Fund. This amount is calculated using the following formula:

```
Acres of Mitigation Required = (Total Acres of Impervious Cover / 0.20) - Acres of Gross Site Area
```

Mitigation Fee = Acres of Mitigation Required at \$25,772.79 per acre

**PART 5.** Council waives the requirements imposed by City Code Section 25-8-41 (*Land Use Commission*) regarding the processing and granting of a variance for the variances granted in this ordinance.

PART 6. This ordinance takes effect on March 7, 2016.
