2. BUSINESS

The Commissioners called this special meeting to discuss what will be said before the Council meeting on March 3, 2016 regarding the status and consideration of accepting the VBE into City Contracts. The Commission supports the creation of the Veteran Business Enterprise as a whole and Chair Jason Denny made a motion to vote in favor of the study and what will be said before the council. Commissioner Bailey Harrington recommended the wording to be as follows "The Veterans Affairs Commission recommends that that city council approves the findings of the recently released disparity study regarding veteran owned business and service disabled veteran owned business. The commission also respectfully requests to be included in the creation of a Veteran Business Enterprise with the City Manager's office prior to presenting any recommended VBE for city council." Commissioner Doug O'Connell seconded the wording and vote and the motion was approved with no objections.
