The Texas Department of State Health Services (TDSHS) allocates federal pass-through funds for the TB Federal Prevention and Control Grant program. The funds assist the City's Health and Human Services Department (HHSD) in providing services for tuberculosis (TB) prevention, control, and outreach services to individuals of identified sub-groups who have TB or who are at high risk of developing TB in the Austin/Travis County service area.						
HHSD was granted an additional \$30,645 in grant funds, an amount that is determined annually based on a TDSHS formula. The additional funding brings the grant award to \$357,645, and will help achieve the goal of improving quality of life and reducing the years of potential life lost due to preventable conditions.
