Street Outreach

Homelessness is a day-to-day struggle to survive.

We provide the safety net of basic needs so youth can start focusing on their strengths and resources available to become self-sufficient.

Myth vs Facts about Youth Homelessness

Myth: Our clients choose to be homeless

Fact: Over two thirds were pushed out of their homes against their will. 83% left abusive homes.

Myth: These kids do not want to get off the streets.

Fact: 89% list shelter in their top three biggest needs, along with food and clothing. 75% strongly agreed that they really want to get out of homelessness.



Myth vs Facts about Youth Homelessness

Myth: Homeless youth are usually the perpetrators of crime.

Fact: About two-thirds of clients have been victimized while living on the street. For every month spent homeless, odds of being victimized increase by 3%.

Myth vs Facts about Youth Homelessness

Myth: All Street Outreach clients are addicted to hard drugs.

Fact: The majority have used alcohol, cigarettes, and marijuana to cope with trauma. Only 16% of survey respondents reported other illegal drug use in the previous month.

Myth: Most Street Outreach clients are heavily involved in a street gang.

Fact: 6.7% reported current gang involvement.
