

AUSTIN CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

BUDGET WORK SESSION MEETING WEDNESDAY, APRIL 27, 2016

The City Council of Austin, Texas convened in a Budget Work Session meeting on Wednesday, April 27, 2016, City Hall, 301 W. Second Street, Austin, Texas.

Council Member Garza called the meeting to order at 9:19 a.m. Mayor Adler, Council Members Casar and Kitchen were absent.

- Presentation of the City's Economic Outlook and Five-Year Financial Forecast.
 Presentation was made by Elaine Hart, Chief Financial Officer, Ed Van Eenoo, Deputy Chief Financial Officer and Jon Hockenyos, President, TXP, Inc.
 - Direction was given to staff to provide Council with the following information: a historical overview of increases and decreases in the property tax bill; a chart that showing the growth of the budget, expenditures and revenues for the fiscal year; an explanation on the purpose of enterprise departments from the standpoint of producing revenue and how that affects their budgeting for expenses versus the revenue.
- Discussion on policy topics for future forecast work sessions.
 Recommendations for other policy topics can be listed on the Council Message Board, a Budget Q&A or by sending recommendations to Ed Van Eenoo, Deputy Chief Financial Officer.

Mayor Pro Tem Tovo adjourned the meeting at 12:20 p.m. without objection.
