Travis County plans to construct roadway and drainage improvements on FM 969 from Decker Lane to FM 973. The City is required to relocate and adjust existing water utilities as necessary to prevent conflict with the proposed County roadway improvements. The proposed roadway improvements will necessitate the relocation of approximately 110 linear feet of eight inch water line, 30 linear feet of 12-inch water line, and 9500 linear feet of 16-inch water lines, including gate valves and fire hydrants. All construction dates are dependent upon Travis County letting, which is tentatively scheduled for Fall 2016.
