*This Committee recommends that the Austin Police Department and the Office of the Police Monitor continue to review the body camera video release policy with a commitment to transparency, individual rights, and fairness to police officers and the public. The Austin Police Department and the Office of the Police Monitor continue to convene meetings with community stakeholders during the development of any policy changes, and that community stakeholders, Austin Police Department and Office of the Police Monitor present the results of this process to City Council within 120 days. Council Member Casar clarified that this will be a recommendation to be passed along to Council at that same meeting when they will be voting on the policy. Motion made by Council Member Casar, seconded by Council Member Pool, motion moved 3/0 with Council Member Houston off the dais; however she had expressed support.*
