

RESOLUTION NO.

WHEREAS, the City Council was requested to conduct a public hearing to consider the use of parkland for permanent water and wastewater uses, to construct, use, maintain, repair, and replace water and wastewater lines for a portion of the 183 South Utility Relocations – Package 12, Boggy Creek to Bolm Road Project through dedicated parkland known as Bolm Road District Park (the Proposed Use”); and

WHEREAS, the land being used for the Proposed Use is described on Exhibit “A” (the “Affected Land”); and

WHEREAS, notice of the public hearing to be held on June 9, 2016, was given for three consecutive weeks on May 15, May 22, and May 29, 2016, in a newspaper of general circulation; and

WHEREAS, such public hearing was held June 9, 2016, by the City Council to consider the use of the Affected Land for the Proposed Use; **NOW, THEREFORE**,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

Having taken into account clearly enunciated local preferences, the City Council finds that there is no feasible and prudent alternative to the use of the Affected Land for the Proposed Use and that all reasonable planning has been done to minimize harm to the Affected Land from the Proposed Use. The use of the Affected Land for the Proposed Use is approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

The City Manager is authorized to take such measures as may be necessary, favorable, or required to effectuate the purpose and intent of this resolution.
