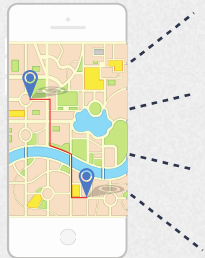

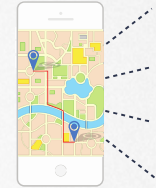

Mobility (Commuting) as a Service

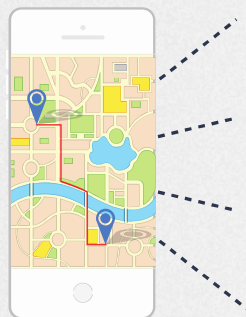

- Partnering with Movability to deliver downtown commuting service
- Demand: Whole Foods, GSD&M, Athena Health, Home Away, SXSW, Cirrus Logic, City of Austin
- Supply: CapMetro, Uber, Lyft, GetMe, SuperShuttle, WeDriveU + Bliss Transit, other
- Globally-scalable commuting solutions “marketplace” exploration underway – above partners on board



RMI transforms global energy use to create a clean, prosperous, and secure future.



- Transit data requirements development (so users know their options and can pay for them)
- Globally-scalable Austin transit data portal/platform design
- Partners: UT-Austin, data.austintexas.gov, Uber, Lyft, CapMetro, cities (SF's 511.org), consumer app developers (Apple, Ridescout, Transit App, Transloc, Hacon, etc.)



- Electrification business model developed
- Austin leading candidate to be next market for Evercar, EV rental service for Uber/Lyft drivers
- Pursuing Austin taxi electrification
- City and Austin Energy aligned around providing charging and incentives for electric fleet vehicles
- Globally-scalable marketplace exploration underway
