PROPOSAL

Demolish a ca. 1946 house.

ARCHITECTURE

One-story, rectangular-plan, front- and side-gabled frame house with a partial-width, front-gabled independent porch on ornamental metal supports; single 1:1 fenestration.

RESEARCH

The house was built in 1946 by a Mrs. Lucille Ross as a rental property. It was listed as vacant in the 1947 city directory. Tenants included a serviceman in the Air Force, a typist at Gracy Title Company, insurance company clerks, a shoe salesman and his wife, who worked as a stenographer for the IRS, a construction worker, a library clerk, and a student.


STAFF COMMENTS

The house is not listed in any City survey.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Encourage rehabilitation and adaptive re-use, then relocation over demolition, but release the permit. The house has neither the architectural nor the historical significance to warrant individual designation as a historic landmark.
