

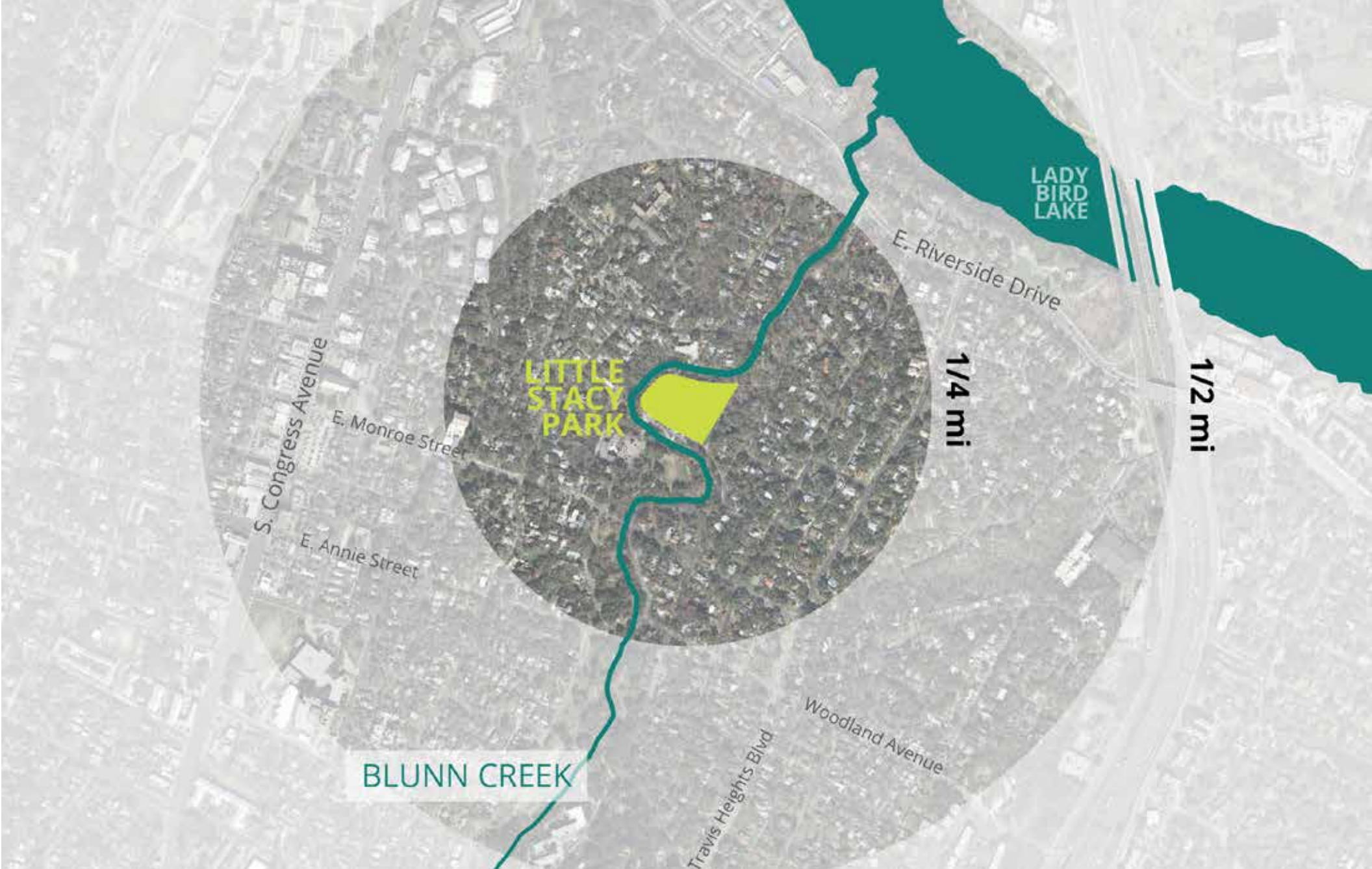

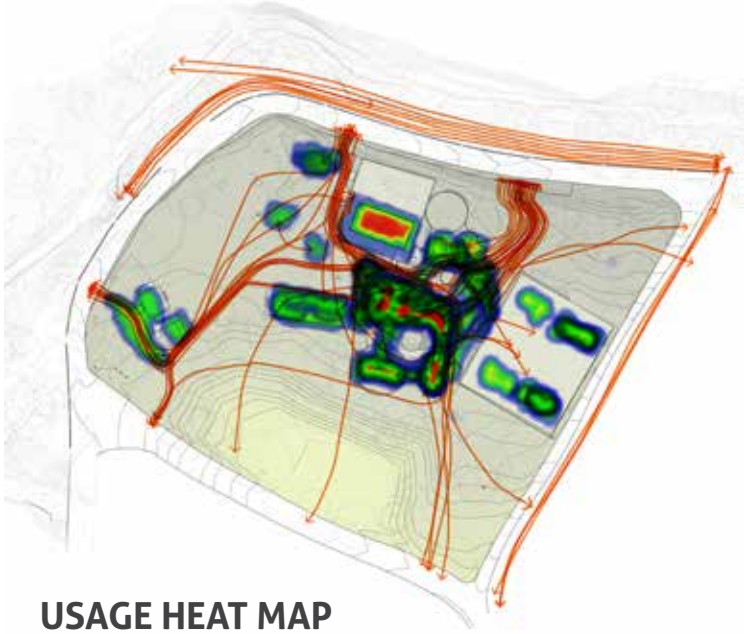

THREE CONCEPTS

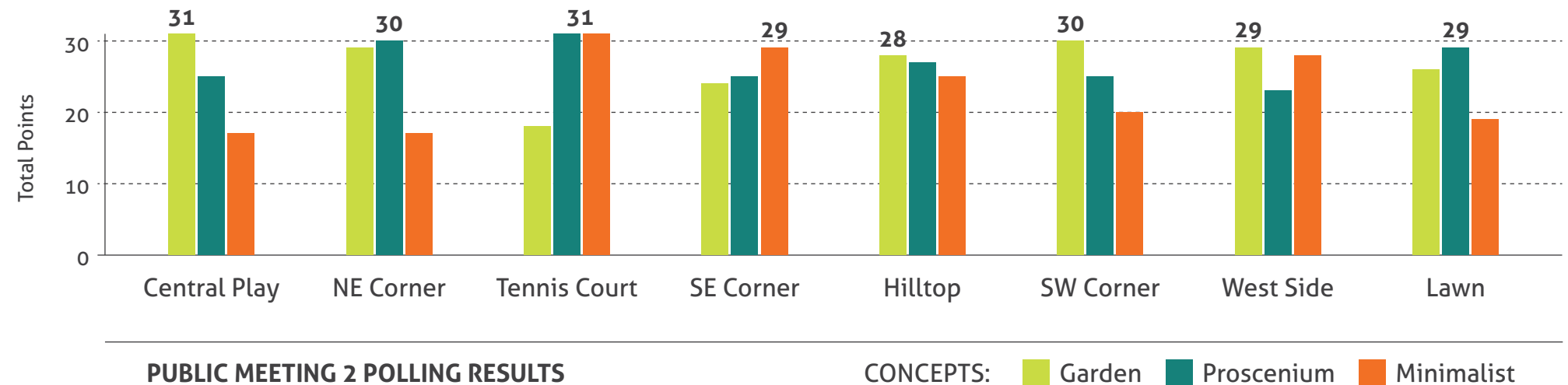
The design team presented three concepts to neighborhoods stakeholders, ranging from “natural” areas and kid-based programs to formal paths, adult activities and water features.

Stakeholders overwhelmingly supported a “light touch” on the site.

WHAT WE HEARD

- Mark and celebrate park entrances
- Manage stormwater with raingardens
- Maintain central play area for kids of all ages
- Resurface two tennis courts
- Improve accessibility throughout the site
- Maintain lawn for open use
- Minimize impervious surface
- Preserve WPA-era design

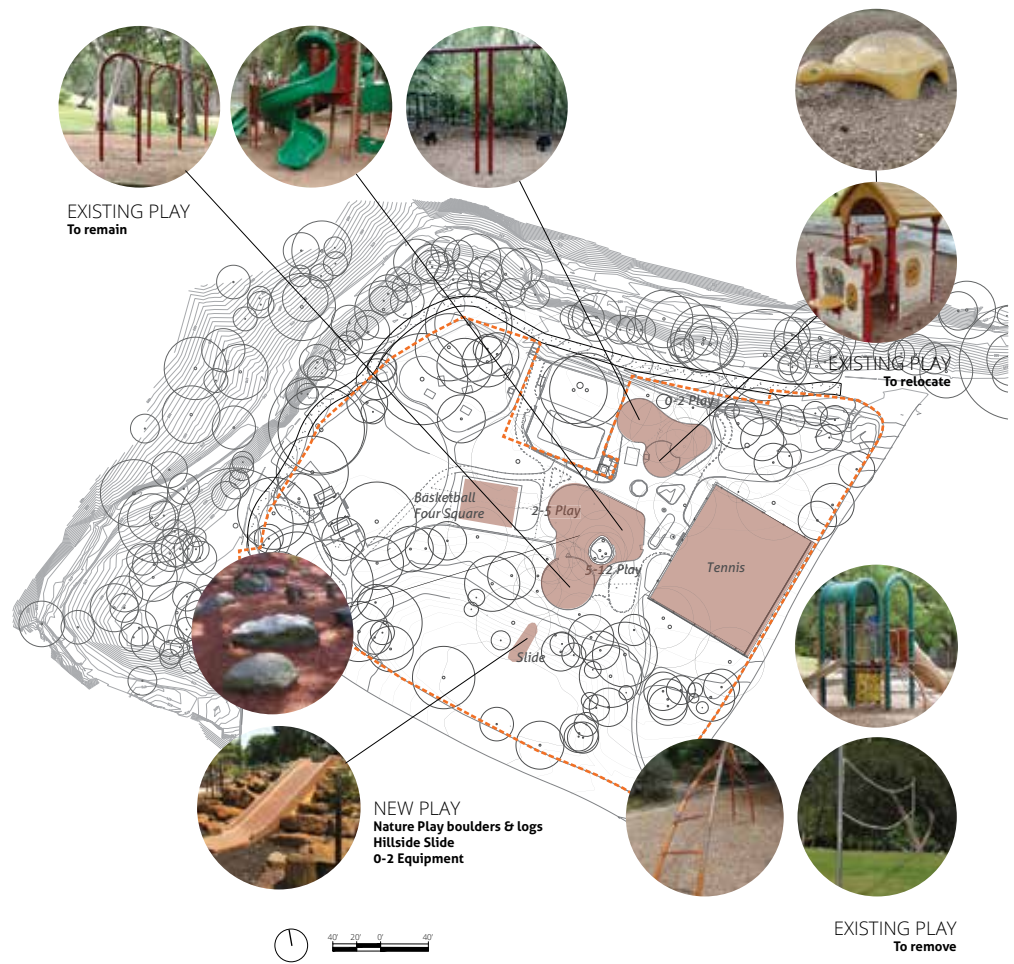
