

ORDINANCE NO. 20160623-036

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 20150908-003 TO REDUCE OR WAIVE SWIMMING POOL FEES FOR CITY OF AUSTIN RESIDENTS WHO ARE HONORABLY DISCHARGED VETERANS OR VETERANS WITH CERTAIN DISABILITY RATINGS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. The City Council finds that:

1. On March 12, 2016, Council adopted Resolution No. 20160512-020 regarding allowing all Honorably Discharged Veterans who are Austin residents, to access all fee-based pools at the same entry fee as senior citizens, and to allow all Service-Connected Disabled Veterans with a Department of Veterans Affairs Disability Rating of 10 percent or greater to access all fee-based pools and secure a season swim pass at no cost.

PART 2. Council amends Ordinance No. 20150908-003 to reduce the cost of access to all fee-based pools to \$1.00 for all City of Austin residents who are Honorably Discharged Veterans.

PART 3. Council amends Ordinance No. 20150908-003 to waive the fees for all fee-based pools and for season swim passes for all City of Austin residents who are Service-Connected Disabled Veterans with a Department of Veterans Affairs Disability Rating of 10 percent or greater.

PART 4. This ordinance takes effect on July 4, 2016.


