Hispanic/Latino Quality of Life Resource Advisory Commission

Recommendation Number: 20160622-004-a3: Discussion and possible action to recommend that the City Council consider the following resolutions.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Hispanic/Latino Quality of Life Resource Advisory Commission requests that the Austin City Council:

Support the Outside the Box Dropout Prevention program for \$84,640, in which the Million Minute Learning Project will provide Montopolis students in grades PK-12, most at risk of dropping out of school due to low academic, social and/or language skills, access to quality, year-round, out-of-school learning, in a format they understand. Funds will be used to deliver 9600 hours of direct academic learning to close the achievement gap between low and high-income youth. Outside the Box will recruit and secure 100-students and coordinate family engagement events to empower all students to engage in challenging coursework and better prepare for college, career, and a future economy driven by technology-based jobs.
