Hispanic/Latino Quality of Life Resource Advisory Commission

Recommendation Number: 20160622-004-a19 : Discussion and possible action to recommend that the City Council consider the following resolutions.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Hispanic/Latino Quality of Life Resource Advisory Commission requests that the Austin City Council:

Support the Tejano Monument Anniversary Celebration for \$26,000.

The Latino/Hispanic Quality of Life Advisory Commission recommends permit and financial support for a proposed parade, a musical performance and a commemorative event to be sponsored by the Austin Tejano Music Coalition on April 8, 2017. These activities are proposed as part of the five-year commemoration of the building of the Tejano Monument at the Capitol grounds. The late-morning parade will include public school children and their parents, members of various organizations and cultural groups from Austin and the surrounding area, members of University of Texas and Austin Community College offices and local, state and national dignitaries. The music venue will include several prominent Tejano bands that will perform all afternoon. The Austin Tejano Music Coalition plans to collaborate with the Texas State Historical Association and the former members of the Board of Tejano Monument Inc. in these festivities. The accompanying activities sponsored by the two latter groups will include a ceremony at the statuary and a scholarly meeting to be held in the Capitol building.
